“Poors Hillock Charity needs you”

Aston Rowant Parish Council is looking to appoint three persons to act as Trustees for the Charity known as Poors Hillock, which provides allotment gardens for the residents of Kingston Blount. The three appointments would be supplemental to the ‘ex officio’ trustee position held by the Lady of the Manor, who has chosen not to participate in the running of the Charity.

Ideally trustees would be resident within the Parish boundary, although this is not an actual requirement under certain circumstances. Those appointed would need to be able to meet as a body to make decisions.

Persons with an interest in the Allotments cannot be appointed as Trustees; therefore no allotment holder or member of the Allotment Association could be a Trustee; neither could family members of allotment holders or members of the Allotment Association.

There is no application form for a Charity Trustee, simply a willingness to serve and the understanding and the ability to carry out the responsibilities involved, which are the general control and management of the administration of the charity.
