Topic for Discussion: Green Spaces

Resolved:

- 1) That the following spaces be put forward as having priority for protection from development in the Neighbourhood Plan:-
 - Aston Rowant Green
 - Land at Five Ways, Church Lane
 - Aston Rowant Cricket Club grounds
 - Hilwerke Trust land
 - Kingston Blount allotments
 - Aston Rowant/Aston Park paddock
 - Kingston Blount Green
 - Land on south side of Kingston Stert Road, between cricket club and KB Green
 - Aston Rowant Churchyard
 - Aston Rowant School (subject to school requirements)
 - Kingston Blount paddocks – original field pattern.

- 2) That other spaces be considered for similar protection on the basis of their contribution to one or more of the following:-
 - The setting of the villages and smaller settlements
 - Registered and unregistered heritage assets
 - Local formal and informal recreational needs
 - Land having local amenity value


- 3) That, unless included within a defined settlement boundary or a schedule of potential developable land, all land in agricultural use, including grazing and woodlands, be deemed inappropriate for new non-agricultural development.

- 2) Status of SODC Register of Open Spaces to be investigated – Mark Thackeray
